Keep in mind, polling under column 2 is not exactly representative of localized riding polling, it's influenced by national polling results as indicated by their [338Canada.com's methodology](https://338Canada.com/methodology). So while polling may seem to heavily favour Liberals/Conservatives, some have challenged these riding-by-riding results. See Burnaby central for example, an NDP stronghold where Liberals are oddly polling stronger than NDP.

2	Mississauga - Streetsville	No 35643 pledges needed	Liberals lead with 51%, followed by Conservatives with 36%, followed by NDP with 7%.	- Rechie Valdez has toed the Liberal Party line and made statements that were largely performative - NDP candidate is openly pro-Palestinian

Conservatives lead with 38%, followed by Liberals at 37%, followed by NDP at 18%.	- NDP MP was silent on Palestine for long, until she eventually repeated calls for recognizing Palestinian statehood and signed onto letter. Still used statements like "Palestinians are dying" - she seems unintegrated with the Palestinian plight at best - disingenuous maybe.
2	New Westminster-Burnaby-Mail lardville	No. It was already swung.	Liberals lead with 35%, followed by Conservatives at 30% followed by NDP at 29%.	MP joined calls for recognizing palestinian state. Condemned collective punishment of Gazans early (Oct. 16, 2023). Visited the West Bank. Brought private members bill for getting justice for Palestinians and Hondurans through Canadian courts.
